IDTHEFT Traveling Safe
TIP

As you make your travel plans, plan how you'll keep your personal information safe. When you're away from home, distractions become opportunities for thieves who are looking for ways to steal your identity. Don't let them ruin your vacation.

These simple steps can save you hours of frustration and hundreds of dollars or more. Before you go:

- Have your mail collected or held at the post office.
- Don't blog, tweet, or post your travel plans
- Decide which credit cards you'll take (as few as possible) and how you'll stash a backup in case one is lost, stolen, or canceled.
- Make a list of important phone numbers
- At home, make sure your financial documents aren't sitting in plain view.

When traveling:

- Don't carry extra credit cards or personal information unless necessary.
- Never leave your purse or wallet unattended.
- Beware of distractions.
- Assume public wireless establishments aren't secure.
- Use cash when possible.
- Confirm credit card numbers in person at hotels instead of over the phone.

If you plan to make any unusual transaction or if you plan on using your cards outside the United States, please call 1-877-809-4216 for credit cards and 1-888-241-2440 for check cards.

To report your ATM/debit card lost or stolen, call 1-888-241-2510 toll free inside the U.S. or 1-909-941-1398 collect outside the U.S.

LIFE MILESTONES

Life changes--such as getting married, divorced, having a child, or facing widowhood--require more than the subsequent emotional adjustment. These milestones also signal the need to take stock financially and make any necessary adjustments.

MARRIAGE

- * Have the money talk. Sit down and set financial goals. Decide if you're going to pool your assets or maintain separate accounts.
- * Corral credit. Exchange credit reports and take a financial inventory.
- * Make name change notifications. Make a list of agencies to notify if you're changing your name.
- * Create or update your wills and powers of attorney.
- * Check your insurance. Update beneficiaries on your policies, your IRAs (individual retirement accounts), and other investments.

- * Educate yourself. Go through financial accounts and figure out where the money is. Pull credit reports.
- * Collect information. Before your first visit to an attorney, make copies of all financial records.
- * Establish credit. Open a checking and savings account in your own name at PTOFCU. Get a credit card in your own name and manage it carefully.
- * Update wills and beneficiaries.
- * Separate credit accounts. Debt incurred in a joint account will follow both spouses after the divorce.
- * Maintain insurance coverage.

DEATH OF A SPOUSE OR PARENT

- * Get 10 death certificates. You'll need these extra copies.
- * Organize finances. Go through all financial papers and make a list of assets and liabilities; gather statements from financial institutions and brokerage companies, insurance policies, employment records, tax returns, and so forth.
- * Cancel accounts and services. Check for and cancel any automatic or online bill paying services unless you'll continue to use them.
- * Contact income providers. Notify old employers, pension fund administrators, and financial institutions holding IRAs or other retirement income accounts. Each may have a different beneficiary.
- * Contact life and health insurance providers. Insurance companies will distribute money to the beneficiary listed on the policy. Don't cancel health insurance until all outstanding bills have been paid.

EXPECTING A NEW BABY (birth or adoption)

- * Understand your finances. If you're planning on moving, buying a bigger car, or want to quit work to raise the baby, you'll need to create a budget that allows you to forecast where you will be financially.
- * Insurance coverage. Visit your employee benefits department to find out what your policy covers, and how much time you have to add a new baby or adopted child to your policy.
- * Create or update your wills.

- * Gather important financial papers. Include real estate records, tax returns, bills, statements, insurance policies and loan information.
- * Eliminate chaos. Create filing systems that work for you.
- * Decide what to keep, where to keep it, and for how long. Think short-term (one year), intermediate term (up to seven years), and long-term (more than seven years).



* Discard unneeded items. Make sure you shred papers that contain personal information.

Use your system when you file all financial records and review every spring.
