CHECK CREDIT REPORTS

When was the last time you took a look at your credit reports from all three bureaus (Experian, Equifax, and TransUnion)? If you haven't checked them in a while, it's a good idea to look them up now and double-check that all the info listed is correct. PREPARE TO STUDENT LOAN REPAYMENT

Federal student loan payments have been on hold since March 2020, but they're set to resume on May 1, 2022. Before that happens, check in on your loans and start planning for what you'll do when payments restart.

SAVINGS PLAN

The end of the year is a great time to look over your income and expenses and make sure that you're saving an appropriate amount for your personal situation. Experts generally recommend saving 10% of your income, but it might make sense to save more or less depending on your needs.
